A Visit to Sharjah Science Museum



A trip to Sharjah Science Museum was organised for the Primary grades of the school in January. This trip was an informative and educational experience for the students. They enriched themselves with a number of hands on activities and visual episodes in the Science Museum.



These two strands are complementary and are therefore anti-parallel to one of two types of the sequence of these bases that encodes information. Using the genetic code, the amino acids within each copying sequence of DNA to RNA, in a process called transcription.

Within cells, DNA is organised called chromosomes. These duplicated before cell replication. Eukaryotic cells have a nucleus and some of the organelles or chloroplasts, prokaryotes (bacteria and archaea) lack a nucleus. In the cytoplasm, various proteins such as histones and other proteins are associated with these complex structures between DNA and other genes which parts of the DNA are



They also showed a keen interest and curiosity in the museum and enhanced their knowledge by finding answers to many questions.




Celebrating the Freedom - The Republic Day


