Children were made aware about the different types of plants, how plants grow, what are there uses. Children did various experiments and recorded their observation




- The environment week provides the opportunity to teach and enhance both environmental science and 'nature of science' activities.

MENTAL MATH COMPETITION




- Towards developing "Mental Math" skills in our Primary and Middle School students we gave them an opportunity to appear for the "Mental Maths Competition - 2017".
