



Teachers Day

Rain Dance



It was language week celebrated to bring about the importance of languages in today's world.






A different language is a different vision of life !!

Grade 1 and 2 has poem recitation in French. Children were well prepared with their rhymes «Alouette Gentille Alouette» et «Une Souris Verte»


Grade 3 and 4 participated in Spell-a-ton with great zeal.

Hindi Language


Language week was celebrated in school from 17th September to 20th September 2017.

The students participated with great enthusiasm. They not only got a platform to test their mathematical skills but also got an opportunity to develop their logical thinking and reasoning abilities.


Through such activities they get accustomed to International system of assessments.
